

## General Rules

### **SAFETY FIRST!**

- Always keep your firearm pointed down range or in a safe direction. Shoot only towards the target, which is backed up by the berm. Paper or Cloth targets only, on backing which will not deflect a bullet off the range. No cans, junk, appliances and especially no glass bottles.
- **EYE AND EAR PROTECTION MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES**
- Never use alcohol or drugs while or before shooting. No one may operate a firearm if they have consumed any alcohol or drugs
- Stay at the firing line except to retrieve or exchange targets. If other shooters are at the line, make sure that the line is clear before proceeding down range. When shooters are down range, all guns should be tabled with the actions open.

## SRSC Rules

- Membership ID in your possession required when using the ranges.
- You must present your Membership ID when asked by an Officer or Member.
- Non-Members cannot use the ranges unless the guest of current Member.
- Report any range violations to the BOD.
- Pick up your brass & trash when you are done.
- No driving vehicles on the ranges.
- Parking in designated lots only.
- No cross firing.
- Minors under age 18 must not use the range unless under the supervision of a Club Member who is an Adult.
- Do not leave unfired 'dud' rounds at the range. Discard them safely.
- Use Brass receptacles. We will recycle all used brass. Do not mix shotgun shells in with the brass.
- Ranges are not to be used for firearm classes without permission of the BOD.
- No shooting before 9 AM on Sundays.
- All Members must sign in & out when using ranges and not at the same time. Placard must be visible on shooting station and returned when done. Placards and Sign in/out Sheet are available in the Clubhouse. This is MANDATORY for all shooters, No Exceptions!
- If you have any questions or suggestions for improvement, please contact the BOD.
- Pistol Range: Shut-off lights, fan, and heat. Pick-Up brass. Lock door.
- Archery Range: Shut-off lights and fan. Close all doors and windows.

## Violations

- 1st Violation: Verbal & Written warning from President, Vice President or BOD.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Violation: Appearance before the BOD to discuss violation. Outcome may include loss of range privileges or expulsion from the club.
